Introduction

Rossendale Borough Council (RBC) is seeking tenders from competent contractors to undertake the following works -:

- To annually inspect , test , repair and install Christmas lighting,
The Rossendale Stock includes - :
Cross the street festoon
Cross the street signs (removed and stored)
Column displays (removed and stored)
Illuminated live trees
Rope lighting
Cribs (removed and stored by another)
- To ensure all works are programmed so that the Christmas lighting is switch on by 1st December or on the specified dates for formal switch on(s) and subsequently all switch off by the first week in January, removed and stored by the end of January.
- To work any unsociable hours within the contract to ensure works are delivered within time scales. And to provided 24hour emergency call service over the seasonal period , with required skills and equipemt
- To attend all formal Christmas lighting switch on (s) ensuring adequate personal to accommodate timely switch on (s).
- To carry out works to be fully compliant with all relevant regulations, standards and guidance's.

Site Information

The Christmas lighting installations are throughout Rossendale mainly on the public highways also within parks, open spaces and markets.

The Contractor must before tendering, ascertain the nature of the location, the extent and nature of the types of work required ,all local conditions and restrictions likely to affect the execution of the works .The detailed design of the installations is the contractors responsibility.

No claim at a later date will be considered on the grounds of lack of knowledge of conditions of access, or nature of the area. The Contractor shall be deemed to have obtained for itself all necessary information as to risks and any other circumstances which might reasonably influence or affect the Contractor's tender. The highways and public access must remain in normal use throughout the works and the safety of public must be ensured at all times.
