NWL are the sole supplier under points 3 and 4 above. They will utilise their existing boreholes (point 4) and they are the only supplier who would have the remit to fund such an investigation, as well as having the knowledge from previous investigation phases to base this phase of work on (point 3)

NB - NWL are an amber list supplier for single tender actions.

Northumbrian Water Limited are putting in the vast majority of the funding for the project themselves, however, the EA also has a responsibility to investigate failures to meet standards. It should be noted that the water company have completed all appropriate investigations into their assets, using their own funding, this has established their spilling assets are not culpable.

The project will provide value for money through partnership contributions from Northumbrian Water and North Tyneside Council (direct contribution from NTC to NWL).

The detailed specification of works will be agreed with us by NWL and with 85% of funding from the NWL value for money is clearly established. We will contribute £15k to an overall budget of £200k, the project will then undertake a programme of sampling, modelling and analysis to identify the issue which will be set out in a technical report for the EA which will be the key deliverable from the contract. This will unlock the situation and allow appropriate fixes to be planned by the relevant party.
