Royal Navy Industry Engagement: Littoral Strike Commando Force Webinar 27 Sep 22.

On 27 September 2022, the Royal Navy will host a **Littoral Strike Commando Force** webinar between 11:00am and 12:00 noon. **Littoral Strike** describes a blend of capabilities which deliver all-domain effects in the littoral; and the **Commando Force** is a specialist, combined land force directed to operate in a manner beyond the remit of conventional forces, with an acceptance of increased level of risk. Commando Forces are optimised to deliver sophisticated effects in littorals and in extreme climates and they have utility across the full range of military operations.

This webinar is a unique industry engagement opportunity. The Littoral Strike Commando Force development team will set out the vision for transforming capability and also describe the challenges it is seeking help to solve. Put simply, against an increasingly challenging and deteriorating global security environment, Littoral Strike must transform to effectively operate and succeed on operations, and meeting those challenges is an exacting task. The proliferation of advanced technologies, which poses both promise and peril, will go some way to address those challenges but adversaries are also transforming their capabilities, and at pace.

The webinar will start a conversation with industry partners; and it is anticipated that this will be the first in a series of events over the coming months and years. The Littoral Strike event will facilitate information sharing and discussion at the Official level only and there are no nationality requirements for the webinar.

This 1-hour webinar will focus on **Mobility**. The session will introduce the Commando Force's interest in tactical mobility of personnel and capabilities which are optimised for long-range manoeuvre in high threat environments and climactic extremes.

There will be no charge for attendance at the webinar and capacity is not limited. Registration will close at midday **20th September 2022**.
