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Site Information

Background:

A Winning MWTS is an existing mine water treatment scheme located close to Alfreton, Derbyshire. The original works involved the construction and installation of a new passive MWTS.

Site Location and Access

In addition to the information in the works information:

- The closest motorway junction is junction 28 off the M1, traveling onto the B6019 which leads to the site via Market Street and Fordbridge Lane, through South Normanton.

- The whole area in the vicinity of the MWTS has been subject to opencast workings


