

Statement of Methodology and Criteria to be adopted In evaluating tenderers' submissions

2024 APTUS Apprentice Programme

- ECITB will evaluate all tenders on the basis of Most Economically Advantageous Tender.
- ECITB will weight and score the price and non-price elements of the tenderer's submission.
- The price information will be submitted in Section 1 of the tender, and the non-price information will be submitted in Section 2.
- The weighting between price and non-price elements is as follows:
 - 25% weighting on price; and
 - 75% on non-price elements.
- Each submission will be scored from a maximum achievable total of 200 points. Thus, up to 50 points will be awarded in respect of the submission relating to price, and up to 150 points will be awarded in respect of the submission relating to non-price elements.
- Each section will be allocated a raw score in line with the tables below which is then multiplied by the relevant weighting factor.

2 nd Best price for the programme delivery & accommodation	4
3 rd Best price for the programme delivery & accommodation	3
4 th Best price for the programme delivery & accommodation	2
5 th Best price for the programme delivery & accommodation	1
