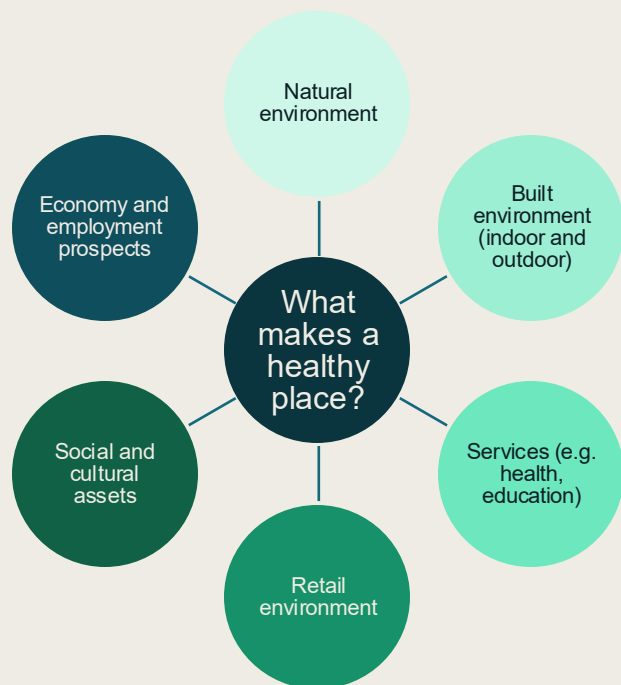


ARE YOU A COMMUNITY ORGANISATION WORKING IN PARKSIDE?
