- 1. We assume the contractor is to be appointed under NEC (4?) conditions, could you confirm which pricing option is being adopted?
- 2. Consultancy Agreement will be a NEC4 Professional Service Contract
- 3. The main contract will be NEC 4A
- 4. Is the ITT asking for a client side 'Technical Advisor role' or is it the PM identified in the NEC contract? NEC Project Manager
- 5. If the former, is a PM already in place to fulfil the NEC PM role. We need to appoint to the NEC Supervisor role
- 6. If the latter, why is a separate cost required for the contract administration? No longer required as CA role should be part of NEC PM activity.
- 7. Has the NEC Supervisor already been appointed? No
- 8. If the NEC PM role is the position required by the ITT, there would need to be a period when the PM reviews the status of the project and its documentation and related systems to ensure these fundamentals to delivery of a successful project are all in place. Understood
- 9. Do you have an anticipated construction contract value or anticipated time requirement for the CA role? Approx. £5,600,000 construction and associated costs.
- 10. We would assume that a number of appointments, specifically the NEC PM, client-side advisor and NEC Supervisor are being made as separate appointments to ensure there are no real or perceived conflicts of interest. Agreed, the Council will be seeking to appoint a NEC Supervisor and NEC PM separately.
