


Task	Quantity	Notes
Restoration of     Mediterranean Temporary     Pond habitat	c. 2800m	Create pathways with shallow depressions (up to 200mm deep) every 20m or so.  Lose arisings/spoil in field boundaries.
2. Excavation of existing meres	2x 95% of each excavated c. 3000sqm	Remove surface vegetation and excavate down to 700mm.  Lose arisings/spoil in field boundaries.
3. Creation of cob pits	c.20 pits c. 1800sqm, ranging from 20sqm to 670sqm	Remove surface vegetation and excavate down to 400mm.  Lose arisings/spoil in field boundaries.
4. Heath burn: cut firebreaks	c.4800m	
5. Heath burn	c. 3.8ha	Six areas to burn are of high priority.
6. Creation of new mere	c. 72sqm	Remove surface vegetation and excavate down to 400mm.  Lose arisings in field boundaries.
