

— Silent (Natural) Beacons
 We love the initiative of the CoastSnap project — both in terms of its social / environmental history, as well as the part it could play in coastal connections. One downside however, of the CoastSnap proposal is the clumsy and disruptive design of its fixtures and fittings that would have a detrimental impact on the coastal environment. Our Silent Beacons is an artistic intervention that improves the design for this project and offers a more sympathetic solution.




— Research and Contextualisation

Borrowing from the language and iconography of the coast as starting point for an idea — our proposal considers an alternative photographic post that is on the one hand a beacon and a structural object that can be understood and recognised in the landscape, but on the other hand is more sympathetic to the natural environment; designed to be 'silent' in carefully chosen locations.

Concept Sketch

The coastal photography posts are handturned, solid oak and incorporate a custom designed milled stainless steel camera phone mount to enable the *CoastSnap* application for the Yorkshire Coast. The component is installed as single unit, orientated to the direction of the scenic view and then fixed in place.

The post is intended to be 'quietly iconic' —

Subtle Sculptures

We would design unique profiles to create silhouettes that are significant to specific locations or parts of a route. Material and construct is sensitive to the environment and sympathetic to the unspoilt coast.
