Upon the execution of each Statement of Work it shall become incorporated into the Buyer and Supplier's Call-Off Contract.

- (a) The Buyer shall advise the Supplier of any specific legal and regulatory requirements that are specific to the Buyer to which the Supplier must be aware of to enable it to provide the Services.
- (b) The Parties agree that optional Call Off Schedule 2 (Staff Transfer) does not apply to this Call-Off Contract as there are no people in scope to transfer upon commencement of this Call-Off Contract.

- (c) Call-Off Schedules 14A and 14B do not apply, and therefore there are no Service Level Agreements, Liquidated Damages or Service Credits associated with this Call-Off Contract.
- (d) In respect of Call-Off Schedule 1, the Parties agree no Transparency Reports are to be provided by the Supplier and the table in 'Annex 1: List of Transparency Reports' to such Call-Off Schedule shall be marked 'not applicable'.
- (e) Paragraph 2.1 of Call-Off Schedule 3 shall be amended to read as follows: '2.1 The Supplier shall, to the extent reasonably practicable given the scope of Services and throughout the Contract Period, identify new or potential improvements to the provision of the Deliverables with a view to reducing the Buyer's costs (including the Charges) and/or improving the quality and efficiency of the Deliverables and their supply to the Buyer. For the avoidance of doubt, the Supplier may fulfil its obligations under this Call-Off Schedule 3 through the provision of the Services set out in the Statements of Work and not in the formats or in line with the timelines set out herein.'
- (f) The body of Call-Off Schedule 4 shall be labelled as 'not applicable'.
- (g) Annex 1 to Call-Off Schedule 5 shall state the following: 'As set out in each Statement of Work.'
- (h) Paragraph 1.5.8 of Call-Off Schedule 7 shall be marked as 'not applicable'.
- (i) Only Part A of Call-Off Schedule 9 shall apply, Part B shall be disregarded.
- (j) All references to 'Key Subcontractor[s]' shall be deemed to have been removed from Call-Off Schedule 10, and the Supplier's responsibilities in respect of Termination Assistance shall be limited to the provision of relevant information and Deliverables produced in the delivery of Services to date.
- (k) For the purposes of Annex 1 to Call-Off Schedule 18, no Relevant Convictions have been identified.
