1	There are 480 new signs being placed, does this mean that the expectation is that there will be a maximum of 480 signs to be taken down and disposed of. If not can you give the actual number of signs that will require removal.	Yes.	24/02/21

	price for each type of sign based on the volume ordered, inputting the costs for the previously mentioned amounts might not reflect the actual cost you would end up paying per sign when the estimated quantity required figure is used. So in the total cost column it will add up the costs for x1, x10, x25 and x50 (86 signs overall) rather than the quantity requested in column F. Should there be a column to input a value for the number of signs in the estimated quantity required column? If not can you please explain the spreadsheet as the Total Cost for each signage type will not reflect the actual cost that would be charged when using the estimated quantity required column (F).	Column F is not intended to reflect actual cost. It is an aid for comparison of proposals.	
5	Column L asks for the 'Unit Cost Provision of Post (£) is this cost for providing an individual post (as covered in cells G8 & G9)? If so what column cost do you want to have included in these cells (L3-6) as you have requested costs for two different post sizes (3m & 5m) and the costs of provision is different dependant on the size of post.
