Subject matter of the processing	<i>Processing data from EPSRC grants to contact PIs so that relevant case studies can be produced as part of an impact evaluation.</i>
Duration of the processing	<i>11th May 2020 - 31st July 2020</i>
Nature and purposes of the processing	<p><i>Publicly available data (all of which is already held by EPSRC) will be used to contact PIs. This will then instigate a series of interviews, workshops and surveys to collect information on impact extracted from various EPSRC investments. The outputs of these interviews etc. will be to produce a series of case studies across each of Energy's research areas that will lead into an overall review of the impact that the programme has had since its inception in 2004.</i></p> <p><i>Research outputs along with the relevant research area, PI name and grant reference number are likely to be included in these case studies.</i></p> <p><i>All relevant data is expected to be passed on to EPSRC and held as these case studies as part of a final report.
