- 1. Can you provide any more detail around these as the scope can vary very widely dependent on the extent? To set the scene, Innovate UK KTN is currently going through a rebrand and we will transition into an identity that is more closely aligned to Innovate UK, to reflect our new position as part of the Innovate UK family. Although the core identity has already been developed and will be launched on the 20th April, we are at the very beginning of this rebranding. We will need support with the continued rollout of the new brand, messaging that clarifies our new position to both internal and external audiences, and the development of family assets that define the role of the Innovate UK group. We also need to make sure these changes are reflected throughout the online user experience. Although this tender doesn't include web development specifically, online content, messaging, and positioning is included.
- 2. 'Content creation' can include things like creation of films, animations, photo shoots; as well as copywriting and messaging. Can you confirm more detail here? All of the above is included, but specifically around corporate communications and activity related to KTN's strategy themes including; Net Zero, D&I, Innovation Adoption and Diffusion, Global Innovation and Place. The Content Creation tender is more to support very niche, sector specific activity.
- 3. Can you confirm that this is not a brief to review or refresh the core brand identity but more about supporting it's roll out and development of sub brands as needed? Correct.
