The requirement

The requirements to be delivered by the Supplier to the Buyer in accordance with RM6002 Attachment 2 Specification – What Customers Need with the additional requirement below:

The Chief Scientific Advisor's (CSA) role covers science in its broadest sense. The role is to ensure that DLUHC's policies, operations, and contribution to wider Government issues are informed by fit-for-purpose science and engineering evidence. The role is also about providing specific scientific, technical and engineering advice on our wide policy portfolio, and champion science in its broadest sense. The postholder will shape and drive the way the Department uses science in the context of the Government's central and ambitious domestic priority to level up the United Kingdom, and effect real change in every community.

This is a broad remit, and DLUHC require a distinguished scientist or engineering leader, with a passion for science that reflects the DLUHC agenda, and be able to demonstrate understanding of the evidence issues underlying key policies. This is a role for a scientist who can maintain a broad and strategic view across a wide range of subjects, policy areas and disciplines.

DLUHC judge that an executive search firm with experience of successfully recruiting Chief Scientific Advisers would be best-placed to support DLUHC with identifying the right talent for this important and specialist role.

DLUHC would be expecting the Supplier to:

- advise on the job description and advertising strategy, working alongside DLUHC HR, and our appointed Civil Service Commissioner;
- conduct a search using their specialist networks to identify suitable candidates and generate a strong field;
- carry out high quality candidate handling keeping candidates informed and engaged throughout the process; and
- evaluate the strengths and weaknesses of each candidate via in-depth preliminary interviews and advise the selection panel accordingly.
