CLARIFICATION QUESTIONS AND RESPONSES

The National Archives has received some clarification questions. Those questions and their associated responses are detailed below.

- Q. Your total expenditure [in this area] over the last two financial years was £48,000. How many roles does/did this account for?
- A. Circa 26
- Q. Which advertising channels do you currently use?
- A. Guardian, Times, Linked In, Indeed, Reed, a number of IT Job boards, Exec. Appointments, Graduate Jobs, National Museums and a range of others depending on the role
- Q. When a job seeker applies to an advertised vacancy, how would you prefer to receive applications? (i.e. is there an application form which should be completed and returned, or, is a CV and covering letter appropriate?)
- A. Candidates apply through our ATS either filling in a form or uploading a CV and statement depending on the role
- Q. Should HR or the hiring manager receive the completed applications in the first instance?
- A. The ATS is managed by the Recruitment Team and recruiting managers are supplied with sift and interview packs
