
**Organisation:** The Innovation Team within StratCom Defence Support Futures will provide primary oversight, management and project management of the Project TAMPA Framework and provide Framework Contractor(s) with primary points of contact.

## Details of the Task Requirement

In this Spiral 2.1 the Authority intends to derive learning from a broader range of parts than just a safety critical item. The focus remains on metallic parts, but the Authority now seeks bids for parts that display one or more of the following criteria:

- It/They must be metallic in nature and different to those being supplied under Spiral 1 (for those Framework Contractors already engaged on Spiral 1).
- It/They can be either non-safety critical or safety critical
- It/They can be fitted to a Fixed Wing (FW) or Rotary Wing (RW) platform or a FW or RW Ground Support Equipment
- It/They can be fitted to platform that has been Granted in Kind (GiK) to Ukraine, or is operating in Ukraine (provided these are covered by an existing MOD Support Contract).
- It/ They achieve acceptance into service and/ or will be fitted to an in-service platform within the period of this task (out to Mar 25)
- It is a/They are part(s) for which there is a shortfall and for which the vendor
  has gained agreement from the DE&S DT that they require these parts
  and will support the process through to onboarding/ fitment onto an inservice platform.

#### Contractor Deliverables:

The Authority also requires evidence of Learning from Experience (LFE), and the Contractor shall deliver an initial LFE report on production of the first part, a second LFE report on conclusion of certification, and a third LFE report once the part has been accepted into service/ fitted onto an in-service platform. These reports will be shared with MOD/ Industry colleagues and thus the Contractor shall deliver both Full and Limited Rights versions under DEFCON 705 to enable appropriate sharing.

Alongside these reports, the Authority also requires the Contractor to actively engage in collaborative events and workshops when required by the Authority to help deliver products to the benefit of Defence.
