Dear Sandra,

Thank you for your recent enquiry concerning the refurbishment of the tennis courts at Old Basing Recreation Ground, Basingstoke.

We are able to carry out the works within the requested dates, the works will take around three to four weeks, weather dependant, however the colour spray cannot be carried out until the warmer, dryer months so would need to be booked in for around May 2021. We can apply temporary playing lines during this time period, this would be an additional £150.00 +VAT per set.

The quotation is based upon our most popular surface which is the ETC Tennis Asphalt. This is ideal for use in this country, where the weather is so often erratic. Because of its unique properties, the macadam is porous and can be played on soon after any amounts of rain. We call this an "All-Weather" surface. After the surface has been laid, an acrylic colour coating is applied, which greatly enhances the appearance of the court, prolongs the surface life and makes it less susceptible to softening in very warm weather. It is ideal for private, club and school use, as it needs very little maintenance throughout the year. This has medium ball bounce and speed, and is the most practical of all sports surfaces.

SECTION 2.00 DETAILED SPECIFICATION

2.01 General Design Requirements

The Employer requires the renovation of three porous macadam tennis courts and one porous macadam tennis court. The courts will be used for competitive tennis and general training and mini tennis and netball activities.

The intention of the Employer is not to restrict the type of footwear used, but the manufacturer's recommendations in this respect will be followed so far as is reasonably practicable. The completed facility is to provide a durable facility requiring the minimum of maintenance. The facility is expected to be used for up to 12 hours per calendar day.

2.02 Construction Materials

Materials and components shall be new, shall comply with British Standards where such exist or other equivalent standards, and shall be delivered to the site in the manufacturer's wrapping where provided. Handling and storage shall be in accordance with manufacturer's instructions.

2.03 Site Clearance & Weed Killing Operations

We shall allow for any site clearance required to carry out the works and also is to carry put any weed killing operations required. We shall allow for the demolition and removal of the two sets of pedestrian access steps to the Northern run back elevations to each of the court blocks.

Manufacturer: Pro Shield Supplied by: Rigby Taylor Dosage: 2litres per 600sq/m

All excavated material arising from the works will be removed from site.

2.04 Construction of Porous Macadam Tennis Courts

The renovation of four tennis courts all as indicated on the site layout drawings. We shall allow for all preparation and remedial works to the existing porous macadam surfacing. This shall include, but not be limited to, rolling with vibrating compaction equipment and repairs to any cracks to the existing macadam surfaces and the repair of any dips, hollows or bumps to provide a stable base for the renovation and a level surface as described in Clause 2.05 below. The renovated courts must meet the porosity requirements of Clause 2.06 and in this tender we have allowed for any works required including piercing the existing porous macadam surfacing to the existing courts in all areas to a depth of 200mm and at a maximum spacing of 450mm centres, the holes are to be filled with clean free draining non-frost susceptible aggregate chippings. The filling aggregate material is to be well consolidated and finished flush with the existing surface and shall be bound in place with an application of bitumen emulsion. We shall allow for any necessary cleaning and power washing of the existing macadam surfaces to remove all vegetation, dirt and debris present.

2.05 Gradients and Levels

The levels provided will have no bumps, hollow ridges, joints, texture variations that would affect ball bounce within the total playing area.

Subject to the above the permitted tolerance in levels will be a maximum deviation of 8mm under a 3m straightedge when assessed using test procedure ITF CS 02/02 dated May 2008.

2.06 Porosity

On the date of practical completion the courts shall have an infiltration rate that exceeds 150mm/h when tested in accordance with BS EN 12616.
